1) PROJECT INFORMATION

It was launched by the Spanish Foundation for Science and Technology in 2008. The SINC team produces news, reports, interviews and audiovisual materials (videos, photographs,

illustrations and infographics). All contents produced by SINC have a Creative Commons 3.0 licence, which means that they can be copied, distributed, publicly communicated, changed and be used commercially, as long as Sinc is quoted as a source. Sinc offers its service to journalists, scientists and citizens to shed light on the latest, most relevant scientific developments, with special emphasis on Spanish studies. The agency's production of information enjoys the participation of the research community, who assist with the revision of publications: breaking news, accuracy and veracity best describe our identity (more than 1.200 journalists and 500 registered institutions)

Potential contribution to the project: Sinc as public sector agency with Creative Commons 3.0 licence enjoying the participation of the research community could provide to the consortium a meaningful and unique contribution as a case of study.

Project idea: The proliferation of fake news makes it difficult for people to know what to believe, creating distrust in the media and in science. Misinformation on the web is a global challenge because it is potentially a threat to our societies. Against this backdrop Sinc, as first state public agency specializing in science, technology and innovation information, is booting trust and reliability at the very heart of scientific communication . Sinc could shed light on identifying good practices and policy guidelines to increase the accuracy and trust in science communication. Also Sinc can contribute to better understand and improve the interactions between scientist and media since part of its activity is underpinned by the participation of the research community.
